Boat Checklist

Important Rules

- Members and guests shall sign a release and waiver of liabilities and return it to the boating chairman prior to checking out a boat.
- Return boats clean, undamaged and ready for the next user
- You are expected to repair any damage incurred under your watch
- 25 hp Mercury can only be used with the Lund because the Lund is covered by club liability insurance. The Mirrocraft is not covered.
- Install Lund bow mount trolling motor per installation instructions found on the SHFC website.
- Use Mirrocraft at your own risk with electric trolling motor or no motor.

Check-out

1. Boat Box contents in order
  - Trailer registration
  - Boat registration
  - Fire extinguisher charged
  - Horn works
2. One PFD per occupant
3. One Throwable PFD (required for the Lund )
4. Oars or a paddle
5. Boat lights work
6. Boat drain plug installed
7. Trailer tires, including spare, inflated
8. Trailer lights work

Check-in

1. Adequate fuel in tank for next user
  - >87 octane <10% ethanol, <5% methanol gasoline
  - Add Stabil to the fuel prior to adding to the tank
2. Batteries connected to charger
3. All equipment returned
4. Clean boat
5. Receipt for boat wire placed on top of checkout form
