

12/9/2024 Cease Fire Chart Directions: Find the table for the range you are on. For the distance you plan to walk to, ask for a cease fire from the ranges that are shown as requiring a cease fire. For example, while you are on the North Range, a cease fire is required of the North Range you are on, and also the 100 yard range when you plan to proceed beyond 26 yards. For distances shorter than 26 yards, a cease fire is required only of the North Range.

RETRIEVE CLAYS	This activity is only allowed on the shotgun range, but only permitted if all other ranges have no activity		

Cease Fire chart was last updated on 12/9/2024 to change the “550 yard range” to the “North Range” for the 2025 Range Rules update. This way, the range can extend to any distance in the future and not impact the name of the range if extension projects are pursued.
